About the Wor

This setting emulates the myriad of 24 angels singing together in the Revelation scripture. Three separate choirs of SSAATTBB voicing unite on the beginning and ending sections. The middle section has the first chorus establish their respective voice melodies on an Alleluia, then continued on as the second chorus sings the same patterns but augmented, and the third chorus sings an augmentation of the second chorus' patterns. An ambitious composition for advanced high school, collegiate, and community choral ensembles.

Program and Performance Notes

- Voicings are characterized and written by their Chorus number then their higher/lower numbering. For example, Soprano 3.1 would be singing in the third (3) Chorus on the higher (1) part.
- The full performing ensemble should be evenly divided among all the written voice parts.
- The beginning and end sections can have some runato at the conductor's discretion.
