Shelley's epic poem is given this musical setting for unaccompanied men's chorus. The haunting, ethereal nature of the text is illustrated with moving motivic lines and solid voice textures. Chordal harmonies propel the work to create further symphonic passages, with the chorus dividing into eight parts at times. Two soloists are also featured narrating the opening and closing of the work. Perfect for your advanced men's choir to perform at your next concert or festival.
