About the Work

A strong, organum-style setting of this psalm moves the melody between all voices as the supporting divisi chorus create echoes within the harmonic progressions. Homophony gets embellished into lyrical phrasings, building and expanding the voice leading toward contrary motion between the upper and lower voices. A final resolve brings the work to a triumphant conclusion. Ideal for worship services, but is also perfect for high school and collegiate concerts and festivals.
